EXODUS 14:21-31, Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and the Lord drove the sea back by a strong east wind all night and made the sea dry land,



and the waters were divided. 22 And the people of Israel went into the midst of the sea on dry ground, the waters being a wall to them



on their right hand and on their left. 23 The Egyptians pursued and went in after them into the midst of the sea, all Pharaoh's horses,




his chariots, and his horsemen. 24 And in the morning watch the Lord in the pillar of fire and of cloud looked down on the Egyptian forces



**and threw the Egyptian forces into a panic,
25 clogging their chariot wheels so that
they drove heavily. And the Egyptians said,**



“Let us flee from before Israel, for the Lord fights for them against the Egyptians.” 26 Then the Lord said to Moses, “Stretch out your hand over the sea,



**that the water may come back upon the Egyptians,
upon their chariots, and upon their horsemen.” 27
So Moses stretched out his hand over the sea,**




**and the sea returned to its normal course

the Lord threw the Egyptians into the midst of the sea. 28 The waters returned and covered the chariots and the horsemen;



of all the host of Pharaoh that had followed them into the sea, not one of them remained. 29 But the people of Israel walked on dry ground through the sea,




**the waters being a wall to them on their right hand

that day from the hand of the Egyptians,**




and Israel saw the Egyptians dead on the seashore. 31 Israel saw the great power that the Lord used against the Egyptians,




**so the people feared the Lord, and they believed

EXODUS 15:1,2, “I will sing to the Lord, for he has triumphed gloriously; the horse and his rider he has thrown into the sea.



found no water.**




EXODUS 14:11,12, They said to Moses, “Is it because there are no graves in Egypt that you have taken us away to die in the wilderness?”

For it would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the wilderness.”




EXODUS 16:3, “Would that we had died by the hand of the Lord in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the meat pots and ate bread to the full,





NUMBERS 13:2-4, The whole congregation said to them, “Would that we had died in the land of Egypt! Or would that we had died in this wilderness!”




3 Why is the Lord bringing us into this land, to fall by the sword? Our wives and our little ones will become a prey.

a leader and go back to Egypt.”**






COLOSSIANS 2:8-10, See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition,

Solution: See Jesus' blood as sufficient




Location #3: Promised Land
